

Aids and scutages : 1245-6 : Aid for getting the king's oldest daughter married

This is the account of the aid of 1245-6 – levied at the rate of 20 shillings per fee – as it appears in the exchequer roll for 1246 (E 372/90, rot 10, IMG_5515). The left margin is damaged, and some of the names are illegible; but the missing words can all be safely supplied (I put them in square brackets), with the help of the next year's roll where help is needed. I have made some additions of my own (these are in pointed brackets) – but none which might not have been made by the scribe himself, if he had been in less of a hurry.
